Information from Hope -

As we begin the new year and implement our updated late fee policy, I would like to share a few important reminders to help ensure a smooth rent payment process for everyone.

Monthly lot rent must be received by **5:00 p.m. on the 5th of each month**, even when the 5th falls on a weekend. **At exactly 5:00 p.m.**, the drop box at the Clubhouse will be taped and closed. If the tape is removed to put a check in the drop box, it **will not** be considered an on-time payment.

For residents using the Rent Payment system, please take a moment to confirm that your **end date is set several years out (for example, 2037)** and that the **minimum and maximum amounts have not been adjusted**. These fields are set by default to ensure the correct rent is pulled and applied accurately to your ledger. Changing them may interrupt successful payment processing.

Lastly, for the best online payment experience, we recommend avoiding the Safari browser. Instead, please use **Chrome, Edge, or Firefox**, as these browsers provide the most reliable performance when submitting payments.

I appreciate your cooperation and attention to these details, which help us maintain consistency and accuracy for all residents. Thank you for your continued partnership as we move into the new year.

Polk County Water Restrictions

Phase II Water Shortage

Polk County, Florida, is under a Modified Phase II water shortage order issued by the [Southwest Florida Water Management District \(SWFWMD\)](#). To comply with the water shortage order, all Polk County Utilities customers will be required to follow a once-per-week watering schedule beginning Sunday, Feb. 8.

The once-per-week watering schedule will apply to all residences, businesses and common areas who are customers of Polk County Utilities, regardless of water source. Customers with private wells and those using reclaimed water will be also subject to the once-per-week watering restriction.

Homeowners associations (HOAs) may not enforce community standards that would require an increase in water usage outside of designated days and times.

If you need assistance adjusting your automatic irrigation timer, please contact Polk County Utilities customer service at [\(863\) 298-4100](tel:863-298-4100) for help.

Customers of other utilities within Polk County are encouraged to review their municipality's or restrictions, as their allowable watering days or hours may differ from those enforced by Polk County Utilities.





The weekly activity emails that are sent by Rose come from a separate email list and may come to all occupants of your home.




